

Garden club to host gazing walk

ANTIOCH - The Antioch Garden Club will present the 13th annual Garden Gazing Walk on Friday, July 18, and Saturday, July 19.

Lunch will be offered Friday. Garden gazing will take place that day from 9:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. And lunch will take place from 1 to 3 p.m.

A tickets for Friday cost \$25 and includes lunch at Elements Restaurant, located at Routes 173 and 59.

Saturday's event costs \$18 and will take place from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Tickets will be available for sale at the State Bank of the Lakes and America United Bank.

There will be six gardens to view in the village and in the countryside. Each garden will feature one or two artisans that will have paintings, jewelry, baskets and photography for sale.

Many decorative baskets filled with items donated by local merchants will be raffled off. The Antioch Garden Club will use the proceeds to maintain village gardens. The club also gives scholarships to local students studying horticulture and has planted trees in the village.

The club is in the process of constructing an area for the Blue Star Memorial to honor the Armed Forces and it supports the local food pantry, Open Arms Mission.

Globally, it helps support Running Waters, Inc., a charitable organization that will help supply water to a small village in Guatemala.
